When morning dawned, the search resumed. They hadn't gone far when they discovered the body of John Clark hanging by the neck from a triangle erected on the ground later occupied by the Idaho State Capitol building.

A few years after Clark's death, a woman, claiming to be his sister, arrived in Boise requesting to remove his remains. The body was exhumed and shipped by freight wagon to Umatilla Landing and from there to Portland, by steamboat. No one arrived to claim the box, which was placed in a storeroom on the dock. After the designated pickup time had elapsed, the box, along with other unclaimed freight, was offered at auction to the highest bidder.

After spirited bidding, the box was purchased by a grocery owner on First Street. His wife and daughter, who urged him to hurry, certain they had an unclaimed treasure in such a large box, accompanied him. The grocer managed to pry off the lid. His wife and daughter helping, they hastily pulled out

the pieces of packing material to find a skull grinning at them. Amid the shrieks and screams of the ladies, the grocer quickly called for help and the box was hastily removed to the back yard.

The grocer was left to dispose of his purchase at his own expense, which he did posthaste. What about the woman who had claimed Clark's body? She disappeared as mysteriously as she had come on the way to Umatilla Landing.

The Vigilante group that had formed as a result of Clark's actions effectively cleared the undesirables from the Boise-Payette valley just as had been done in Lewiston, finally creating a law-abiding area for its residents.

by Mick Barnes of Jerome, Idaho. Mick has owned Barnes Custom Farming since 1982. They plow, haul potatoes, and dig potatoes. Barnes got started racing when he was just a kid in high school. He started out drag racing a 1957 Chevrolet .327 with a four speed and 456 racing gears in the rear end. Mick went from drag racing to sand racing and finally ventured into mud racing after watching it on television one day. He decided that mud racing was what he needed to be doing so he and another local, Terry Budd, put on their first mud race in Gooding, Idaho in 1979. Mick promoted for several racing seasons with Terry and decided that racing was a lot more fun than putting the shows on, so he dropped promoting and continued racing.

Mick raced a 1947 flat fender Jeep CJ2 for the first 25 years in the stock class. During those 25 years, he won first place approximately 95% of the time. His racing venues include Green River, Wyoming, and most of southern Idaho including: Castleford, Soda Springs,

on continuing to race in the ProMud class and the only change he's planning on making to Troublemaker is changing the back tires to straight panels instead of cross panels, which will allow him to get more traction. At 1200 HP, there's too much horsepower and the tires just spin on launch so Mick plans on putting on SKat-Trak super scoops, 17x36x16s with 21 paddles per tire.

he US standard railroad gauge (distance between the rails) is 4 feet, 8.5 inches. That's an exceedingly odd number.

Why was that gauge used? Because that's the way they built them in England, and English expatriates built the US railroads. The first coast-to-coast rail line in the US was completed in 1869 with the driving if the Golden Spike near the present Thiokol plant at Promontory Point, Utah

Why did the English build the railroad tracks like that? Because the first rail lines were built by the same people who built the pre-railroad tramways, those cute little rail cars like those still in use in San Francisco. That was the gauge the tramways used.

Why did the tramways use that gauge? The people who built the tramways used the same jigs and tools that they used for building wagons, which used that wheel spacing.

Stay with me, this is where it gets interesting, as we travel back through time.

Why did the wagons have that particular odd wheel spacing? Well, if they tried to use any other spacing, the wagon wheels would break on some of the old, long distance roads in England, because that's the spacing of the wheel ruts.

So who built those old rutted roads? Imperial Rome built the first long distance roads in Europe (and England) for their armies. The roads have been used ever since.

And the ruts in the roads? Roman war chariots formed the initial ruts, which everyone else had to match for fear of destroying their smaller, weaker wagon wheels.

Since the chariots were made for Imperial Rome, they were all alike in the matter of wheel spacing. Therefore the United States standard railroad gauge of 4 feet, 8.5 inches is derived from the original specifications for an Imperial Roman war chariot.

The chariots of the Imperial Roman army were made just wide enough to accommodate the rear ends of two war horses, a larger breed than those commonly ridden today. Now, the twist to the story:

When you see a Space Shuttle sitting on its launch pad, there are two big booster rockets attached to the sides of the main fuel tank. These are solid rocket boosters, or SRB's. The SRB's are made by Thiokol at their factory near Promontory Point in Utah.

The engineers who designed the SRB's would have preferred to make them a bit fatter, but the SRB's had to be shipped by train from the factory to the launch site. The railroad line from the factory happens to run through a tunnel in the mountains, and the SRB's had to fit through that tunnel. The tunnel is slightly wider than the railroad track, and the railroad track, as you now know, is about as wide as two horses' behinds.

So, a major Space Shuttle design feature of what is arguably the world's most advanced transportation system was determined over two thousand years ago by the width of a horse's rear end.

And so it goes. Who knows where or on what planet it might end? That's what makes history interesting. There are always ties to the present and to the future. ■




